RULES & REGULATIONS

All artists are invited to enter this competition according to the rules listed below. The show's theme of "Well-Being" is open to the artist's interpretation.

- ❖ **Artwork must be original (no copies).**
- ❖ Artists must be age 18 or older and may submit only one entry.
- ❖ The artwork date of creation must be 2020 or later.
- ❖ All media will be accepted with the exception of photography, jewelry, crafts and/or digital artwork. Recycled required to be 80% recycled, 20% other materials.
- ❖ Nudes will not be accepted.
- ❖ Two-dimensional artwork shall not exceed 40" in either direction and must have hanging wire on the back (no sawtooth hangers).
- ❖ Three-dimensional artwork shall not exceed 48" in any direction or weigh over 25 pounds.
- ❖ Wrapped stretched canvas must be finished on all sides and all other two-dimensional artwork must be framed.
- ❖ Assembly is not permitted after entry.
- ❖ Artwork must remain on display until the pickup date.

JUROR OF AWARDS

RACHAEL BAAR has been the Curator of the National Quilt Museum in Paducah, Kentucky, since 2017. Prior to her present position, she was the Director of the Henderson Fine Arts Museum (now the Preston Arts Center) from 1996 to 2017, where she supervised professional staff and collaborated with community organizations and businesses to plan art exhibitions, performances, workshops and other special events. She was also appointed the Director of Public Relations for Henderson Community College working with the grant writing team from 2001 to 2010.

Ms. Baar's professional experience includes serving as juror for *Seeing Stars*, Southeast Missouri Arts Council (August 2021) and *Form Not Function*, The Carnegie Center for Art & History, New Albany, Indiana (March 2018), and as Guest Curator for *Textile Talk* with Studio Art Quilt Associates Artists of the *Musical!* exhibition (June 2020).

She holds a Master of Science in Management from Brescia University, a Master of Science in Education from University of Kentucky, and a Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education from Murray State University.
